5 skeins of fingering weight yarn (approx. 1000 yards total)

- US size 6 (4mm) knitting needles
- US size 8 (5mm) knitting needles
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors

Abbreviations:

- CO Cast on
- K Knit
- P Purl
- YO Yarn over
- K2tog Knit two stitches together
- P2tog Purl two stitches together
- SSK Slip, slip, knit (slip the first two stitches onto a spare needle, hold them in front of your work, and knit them together)
- SKP Slip, knit, pass slipped stitch over (slip the first stitch onto a spare needle, knit the next stitch, and then pass the slipped stitch over the knitted stitch)
- Rep Repeat

Instructions:

1. Cast on Lace Panel: Using US size 6 (4mm) needles, CO 150 sts.

2. Lace Pattern:

- Row 1 (RS): K2, *YO, K2tog, YO, K6; rep from * across, end K2.
- Row 2 (WS): P2, *P2tog, YO, P6; rep from * across, end P2.
- Row 3 (RS): K2, *YO, SSK, YO, K4; rep from * across, end K2.
- Row 4 (WS): P2, *SKP, YO, P4; rep from * across, end P2.
- 3. Repeat Rows 1-4 until lace panel measures approx. 18 inches from CO edge.

- 4. Ribbing for Cuffs: Switch to US size 8 (5mm) needles.
 - Row 1 (RS): K1, *P1, K1; rep from * across, end K1.
 - Row 2 (WS): P1, *K1, P1; rep from * across, end P1.
- 5. Repeat Rows 1-2 of ribbing for approx. 3 inches.
- 6. Shape Cuffs:
 - Row 1 (RS): K1, *P1, K2tog; rep from * across, end K1.
 - Row 2 (WS): P1, *K1, P2tog; rep from * across, end P1.
 - Repeat Rows 1-2 of shaping until 25 sts remain on each needle.
- 7. **Bind Off:** Bind off all sts on both needles using your preferred method.
- 8. **Finishing:** Weave in all loose ends and block the shrug according to manufacturer's instructions.

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With the completion of your "Renee" lace shrug, you now possess a timeless and elegant garment that will complement any special occasion. Its intricate lacework and ribbed cuffs add a touch of sophistication that will turn heads wherever you go. 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
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
