With sizes included for babies, toddlers, and children, you can find the perfect fit for your child. The pattern includes detailed instructions and helpful photos to guide you through each step of the knitting process. So grab your needles and yarn and get started on this fun and rewarding project!

## Materials

- Worsted weight yarn in two colors (main color and contrast color)
- Knitting needles size 8 (5mm) or size needed to obtain gauge
- Cable needle
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

## Gauge

16 stitches and 20 rows = 4 inches in stockinette stitch

## Sizes

Baby (6-12 months): 14" circumference x 8" height

Toddler (1-3 years): 16" circumference x 8.5" height

Child (4-10 years): 18" circumference x 9" height

## Instructions

1. Cast on 96 stitches with the main color yarn.
2. Knit in stockinette stitch (knit one row, purl one row) for 2 inches.
3. Begin the cable pattern:
  - Row 1: Knit 12, cable 6, knit 12, cable 6, knit 12, cable 6, knit 12
  - Row 2: Purl all stitches.
  - Row 3: Knit 6, cable 6, knit 12, cable 6, knit 6
  - Row 4: Purl all stitches.
  - Repeat rows 1-4 for the desired length of the hat.
4. Shape the crown:
  - Row 1: \*Knit 12, cable 6, knit 6\*
  - Row 2: Purl all stitches.

- Row 3: \*Knit 6, cable 6, knit 6\*
  - Row 4: Purl all stitches.
  - Repeat rows 1-4 until there are 24 stitches remaining.
5. Cut the yarn, leaving a 6-inch tail. Thread the tail through the remaining stitches and pull to close.
  6. Sew the side seam of the hat.
  7. Make the bear ears:
    - Cast on 12 stitches with the contrast color yarn.
    - Knit in stockinette stitch for 6 inches.
    - Bind off all stitches.
    - Repeat steps 1-3 to make the second ear.
  8. Sew the ears to the top of the hat.
  9. Make the bear eyes:
    - Cut two small circles out of black felt.
    - Sew the circles to the front of the hat.
  10. Make the bear nose:
    - Cut a small oval out of brown felt.
    - Sew the oval to the front of the hat.
  11. Make the bear mouth:
    - Embroider a small line across the bottom of the nose.

Congratulations! You have now completed your cabled bear hat. This adorable hat is sure to keep your little one warm and cozy all winter long. Enjoy!
