

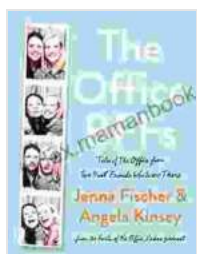
Tales of the Office: Exclusive Interviews with Two Best Friends Who Were There

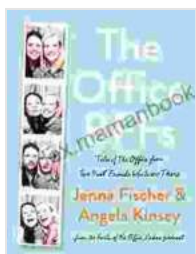
The Legacy of 'The Office'
